



PC 6000 ONE DRIVE SYSTEM ADDENDUM

The PC-6000 is configured the same as our PC-8000 with the exception of the disk drives. The PC-8000 is a double drive system where as the PC-6000 is a single drive system. The manuals supplied with both computers refer to a double drive system. The only difference you will encounter while using the PC-6000 is in the operation and use of the MS-DOS command structure. The commands used for disk functions, such as Format, Diskcopy, and DIR will be in a one drive form. In the manual you will see the following:

```
A>Format b:  
A>Diskcopy a: b:  
A>DIR b:
```

The "b:" in the above examples, refers to the second drive on the PC-8000. The PC-6000 having one drive does not allow the "b:" command. Therefore you would disregard "b:" in your commands. This allows the use of your single drive system, with the full DOS command set of the double drive system. On the PC-6000 the above examples would be changed to the following:

```
A>Format  
A>Diskcopy  
A>DIR
```

To give you an example of how a one drive system would work with diskcopy, you would type and see the following:

```
Boot the DOS Disk  
At the prompt type:  
A>Diskcopy <return>
```

You will then be prompted to alternately insert the source and target disks in the A> drive at the appropriate times. When copy is finished, you will be prompted as to whether you would like to continue or stop.

More information on the usage of a single drive system can be found in Appendix A of the "Microsoft MS-DOS 3.1 User Reference Manual". This manual is supplied with the PC-6000 and PC-8000 computer systems.

QUICK SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

To achieve the best results with your new Franklin PC-8000 personal computer system, you should read the enclosed manuals. If, however, you are impatient to see it work, follow these simple instructions to set up your machine and get started. Then, please do take the time to read the detailed instructions with the machine and with any programs you may purchase.

Step 1: Unpack the Franklin system unit, keyboard, power cord and manuals, taking care to save the packing materials in case of any trouble. Set the system unit up on a flat surface, such as a desk.

Step 2: Connect the cable coming from the keyboard to the socket on the bottom right of the unit, as seen from the back. Note that the connector is keyed and will only fit in one direction.

Step 3: Connect the power cord to the power plug on the bottom of the left rear of the system unit, as seen from the back. Make sure that the power switch (top left on the back) is off (the 0 side should be pushed in). Plug the other end of the power cord into a 3-wire grounded wall outlet.

Step 4: Unpack your monitor and place it on top of the system unit. Plug its power cord into a grounded wall outlet.

Step 5: Take the monitor cable and connect one end to the video output jack on the monitor. The other end may be one of two types. If it is a single pin plug (called an RCA type phone plug), it will go into the middle outlet on the top left set of connectors on the back for a monochrome monitor or the leftmost outlet for a composite color monitor. If the connector has a 9-pin plug, this should be plugged into the socket which is next to the two RCA phone jacks.

Step 6: Turn the monitor power on.

Step 7: Remove the protective cardboards from the disk drives by turning the levers on the front of the drives one-quarter turn clockwise.

Step 8: Place the Franklin PC-8000 Welcome diskette in the upper (A) drive with the disk label face up and at the outer edge of the disk.

Step 9: Turn the power switch to the system unit on. The disk drive light will come on and in several seconds, information will appear on the monitor screen.

Step 10: Follow the instructions as they appear on the screen.

PC-8000 Compatibility Update

As Franklin continues to test software both in house and with software publishers, we will provide lists of titles which do and do not run on the PC-8000. Software titles will fall into one of three groups: 1) Titles that RUN, 2) Titles that do not run because of hardware/software configuration requirements, and 3) titles which do not run.

Starting this month the PC-8000 run list will be grouped by categories: Business, Education, Games, and Utilities. This is the same format we use with the 2000 and 500 series lists.

Titles which have been tested by either Franklin, publishers or testing labs which do RUN on the PC-8000.
